

To study English effectively, you should focus on different skills and materials depending on your **level**. Here's a breakdown of what should be studied at **three main levels**:

◆ 1. Beginner (A1–A2)

Goal: Build basic vocabulary, grammar, and speaking confidence.

Focus Areas:

- **Vocabulary:** Daily life (family, food, time, numbers, weather, colors)
- **Grammar:**
 - Basic tenses (Present Simple, Past Simple)
 - Articles (a, an, the)
 - Pronouns, prepositions, plurals
- **Skills:**
 - Listening to slow, clear English (e.g. kids' shows or beginner podcasts)
 - Reading short texts (e.g. dialogues, simple stories)
 - Speaking basic sentences (introducing yourself, asking directions)
 - Writing simple sentences and short paragraphs

◆ 2. Intermediate (B1–B2)

Goal: Improve fluency, expand vocabulary, and master common grammar.

Focus Areas:

- **Vocabulary:** Education, jobs, travel, opinions, feelings, technology
- **Grammar:**
 - All major tenses (Present Perfect, Past Continuous, Future forms)
 - Conditionals (if sentences), comparatives/superlatives
 - Modals (can, must, should, etc.)
- **Skills:**
 - Listening to podcasts, news clips, and movies with subtitles
 - Reading articles, short stories, and essays
 - Speaking on various topics with explanations

- Writing emails, stories, and opinion paragraphs

3. Advanced (C1–C2)

Goal: Achieve fluency, accuracy, and academic or professional English ability.

- **Grammar:**
 - Advanced structures (inversions, cleft sentences, passive voice)
 - Complex clauses and stylistic variety
- **Skills:**
 - Listening to fast-paced content: documentaries, debates, TED Talks
 - Reading newspapers, academic articles, and literature
 - Speaking with persuasive and formal language
 - Writing essays, reports, and formal letters
